 <p>Tap Tap See</p> <p>Allows visually impaired/blind to identify objects encountered in everyday life without need for sighted assistance Uses camera to capture image and hear the description back to you Free Available on Android and Apple</p>	 <p>Lookout by Google</p> <p>Uses rear facing camera to identify environmental items and report the information (i.e. signs, locations, people/objects, text). Free Available on Android</p>	 <p>Seeing AI</p> <p>Uses rear facing camera to identify and narrate the world around you, such as objects, text, and people Free Available on IOS/Apple</p>
 <p>Supersense</p> <p>Has an Object Explorer mode to stream video from your camera and identify what is seen, verses having to take a photo and waiting for it to analyze. Free, in app purchases available Available on Android and iOS</p>	 <p>Be My Eyes</p> <p>Pairs you with a sighted volunteer to help identify objects using smartphone and camera via live video chat. The app will ring until both sides are connected to begin Free (required data or wifi) Available on Android and iOS</p>	 <p>Bespecular</p> <p>Pairs with a remote volunteer for assistance on whatever you need. Can send questions along with photos for feedback. Free Available on Android and iOS</p>
 <p>Cash Reader</p> <p>Assist with cash handling. It will speak the denomination, but also vibrate and display in large contrasting numbers on the screen for any discreet situational needs.
