

Save money with the **Blues'** 90-Day Retail Prescription Program

Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan's 90-Day Retail Prescription Program saves you money on prescriptions that you take on an ongoing basis. You can get up to a 90-day supply of your prescriptions at a retail pharmacy for a reduced cost.

To use this benefit, ask your doctor to write a new prescription for an 84- to 90-day supply. Take the prescription to your local pharmacy to be filled. You'll pay less than the three separate 30-day copayments you would normally pay for a 90-day, or three-month, supply of the drug.

Most chain and many independent pharmacies in Michigan participate in the BCBSM 90-Day Retail Prescription Program, as do about half of all network pharmacies outside of Michigan. Ask your pharmacist if he or she participates in the program before having your prescription filled. For a complete list of participating pharmacies in Michigan, go to **bcbsm.com/pharmacy**, then:

## Here are some things you need to know before you use the 90-Day Retail Prescription Program:

- Ask your doctor to write a new prescription for an 84- to 90-day supply.
- Prescriptions for a supply of 31 to 83 days cannot be filled at a retail pharmacy.
- State laws must allow the dispensing of a 90-day supply for the medication you are receiving.
- The 90-Day Retail Prescription Program is not mandatory.
- If you have mail order prescription drug coverage, you can still receive up to a 90-day supply of your medication through mail order.
