### Conditions of Agreement for Student

1. All articulating students shall meet and maintain Delta entrance requirements.
2. Articulated credit will be granted at the discretion of the CTE High School Teacher for any Delta AUTO course(s) listed on this application upon successful completion of the equivalent ASE course at any CTE high school institution with the [ASE MLR Level 1 Automotive Technician Program](#). Successful completion is validated by achieving a minimum grade of “2.0” in the course.
3. Students may articulate up to the 24 credits (540 hours of class and lab time; the 80-hour Internship; and ASE G1 Certification Test) which is required in MLR Level 1 at Delta. Articulated courses will appear on the student’s Delta transcript by course code and credit hours. No grades will be recorded. Students can view their articulated courses on their unofficial transcript through their Student Self-Service account.
4. Any unfinished MLR Level 1 coursework can be completed at Delta.
5. Tuition and fees will not be charged for articulated courses under this agreement.
6. The student must have graduated from a High School Institution with an ASE MLR Automotive Technician Program no more than 27 months prior to enrollment at Delta to receive articulated credit. After 27 months the articulated credit will expire and not be available for articulation.
7. Only one MLR Statewide Articulation Application Packet should be submitted per student after their highest level of the ASE MLR Automotive Technician Program is completed.

### Procedure to Articulate Some or All 24 Credits of the MLR Level 1 Program

1. The High School Teacher completes the MLR Articulation Application Packet, certifying that the student has completed all outcomes and objectives of the required level of courses indicated on the documentation and that he/she feels confident that the student can successfully complete subsequent coursework at Delta.
2. **To be accepted, all paperwork listed below must be completed and submitted to [articulation@delta.edu](mailto:articulation@delta.edu) by the High School Teacher.**
  - a. Completed MLR Articulation Application Packet
  - b. Documentation that the 80-hour MLR Internship (page 3 of this packet) has been completed
  - c. Copy of the ASE G1 Certification Test - Note: The ASE GS1 student test provided by many high schools is **NOT** equivalent to completing the ASE G1 Certification Test.
